I am writing in response to the correspondence you submitted through the Office of the Commissioner regarding concerns you have raised about the RCMP and the handling of matters that you have reported. Your package and accompanying materials have been reviewed.

Thank you for taking the time to share your concerns. The RCMP recognizes the importance of ensuring that all reports received from members of the public are taken seriously and assessed in accordance with applicable laws, policies, and investigative standards.

With respect to the allegations of sexual assault that you referenced in your correspondence, I can confirm that the matter remains under investigation. As the investigation is ongoing, it would be inappropriate for me to comment on investigative steps, evidence, or potential outcomes at this time.

You have also raised several concerns regarding RCMP members and their actions. These concerns are currently being addressed through the appropriate channels via the Civilian Review and Complaints Commission (CRCC) process. As part of that process, the matters raised will be reviewed and assessed in accordance with the established procedures and authorities governing public complaints against the RCMP. Any findings or determinations will be made through this process.

Please be assured that the Nova Scotia RCMP remains committed to conducting investigations in a fair, impartial, and professional manner. We are also committed to treating all individuals with dignity and respect throughout the investigative process.

Thank you again for writing and for bringing your concerns to our attention.
